Data security measures:

MOHAnet stores personal data in electronic form on its own servers and sometimes employs a data processor. In the case of any outsourcing of data processing, it shall ensure that the service provider used provides the appropriate guarantees of data processing. MOHAnet will take appropriate measures to protect personal data, including from unauthorised access or alteration.

Rights related to data processing:

Right to information and access:

You may request information from MOHAnet through the contact details provided under the subheading "Data Manager" about

- · what personal details,
- on what legal basis,
- for what purpose,
- from which source
- how long it treats,
- whether it still manages your personal data,
- to whom, when, for what reason and which personal data were granted access to or to whom the personal data were transferred.

In addition, you can request a copy of your personal data stored by MOHAnet. MOHAnet will fulfil your request within a maximum of 30 days by sending a reply to the contact information provided in the request. If you send the request electronically to MOHAnet, then MOHAnet's reply letter will also, if possible, be sent electronically. If you request a reply by other means, please indicate this in the request.

Right to rectification:

You may request in writing MOHAnet to modify or clarify any of your personal data (e.g. name, email address, if any change has occurred) through the contact details provided under the "Data Controller" subheading. If you send the request electronically to MOHAnet, MOHAnet's reply letter will also, if possible, be sent electronically. If you request a reply by other means, please indicate this in the request.

MOHAnet will execute your request within a maximum of 30 days without undue delay and inform the applicant thereof by sending a letter to the contact details provided by him.

Right of cancellation ("right to forget")

You may request MOHAnet in writing to delete your personal data through the contact details provided under the subheading "Data Controller".

MOHAnet rejects a request for deletion in the event that MOHAnet is required by law to further store personal data. However, if there is no such obligation for the personal data requested to be deleted, MOHAnet will fulfil the request without undue delay and within a maximum of 30 days and inform the applicant thereof by sending a reply to the contact details provided by him. If you send the request electronically to MOHAnet, MOHAnet's reply letter will also, if possible, be sent electronically. If you request a reply by other means, please indicate this in the request.

Right to restrict data processing

You may request MOHAnet in writing to restrict data processing through the contact details provided under the subheading "Data Manager". In case of restriction, MOHAnet may only store personal data; other processing activities may take place only with the consent of the applicant for the restriction because of the submission of a legal claim or in the public interest.

Restriction of data may be requested if:

- you believe that your data is not accurate, or
- you think that your data has been unlawfully processed by MOHAnet, but you do not want to delete the data.
- it requires processing to enforce or protect your legal claim, but MOHAnet no longer needs this data.

MOHAnet will execute your request without undue delay and within a maximum of 30 days and inform the applicant thereof by sending a letter to the contact details provided by him. If you send the request electronically to MOHAnet, MOHAnet's reply letter will also, if possible, be sent electronically. If you request a reply by other means, please indicate this in the request.

Right to withdraw your consent

You may withdraw your consent to the processing at any time in writing through the contact details provided under the "Data Manager" subheading. In the event of withdrawal of consent, MOHAnet's processing of data prior to revocation will continue to be lawful.

MOHAnet deletes the personal data without undue delay after receipt of the revocation and shall inform the declarant thereof by sending a letter to the contact details provided by him. If you send the request electronically to MOHAnet, MOHAnet's reply letter will also, if possible, be sent electronically. If you request a reply by other means, please indicate this in your statement.

Remedies

If you consider that the processing did not comply with the legal requirements, you can initiate the proceedings of MOHAnet's data protection officer or go to court.

In addition, an inquiry may be initiated by a notification to the National Authority for Data Protection and Freedom of Information on the grounds that there has been, or there is an imminent risk of, a violation of rights relating to the exercise of personal data processing.

Detailed Information other than the general information:

Details of data processing related to the website of www.mohanet.hu:

MOHAnet is the responsible manager of your data during your visit to the website.

When you visit MOHAnet's website, you also provide us with your personal information.

MOHAnet processes your personal data for the purpose of applying for advertised jobs and future use for vacant or new positions, as well as selecting the right workforce and communicating with you. Providing data and information in addition to the data and information requested in the specific application form depends on your free consent.

If the material you upload contains special personal data, MOHAnet will contact you for handling it.

Your data can be accessed by MOHAnet employees in order to perform their tasks. For example, personnel administrators learn about your personal data when performing their tasks related to organizing and conducting the selection process. Further, your data are learned by the managers and their employees who participate in the selection process.

In case by exercising of your rights you request MOHAnet to delete your personal data, this will result in the interruption of the selection process so you will not be selected.

Details of data processing obtained during the device administration:

In the process of concluding the contract, it is necessary to register individual remote monitoring devices, and it requires recording of the personal data of customers and contacts. We will only use the personal data provided to the extent necessary for the performance of the contract.

Every employee who has access to personal data handles it on the basis of his job or office and is obliged to protect and preserve it in accordance with our internal regulations. The data processing persons are obliged to keep the personal data they know as confidential.
